this is not a library book.

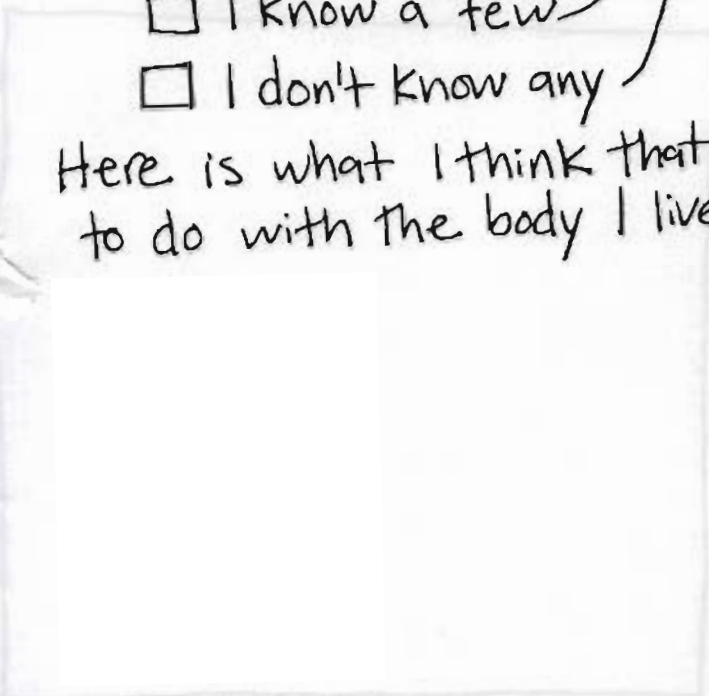
This is what it was like for me growing up as boy/girl.

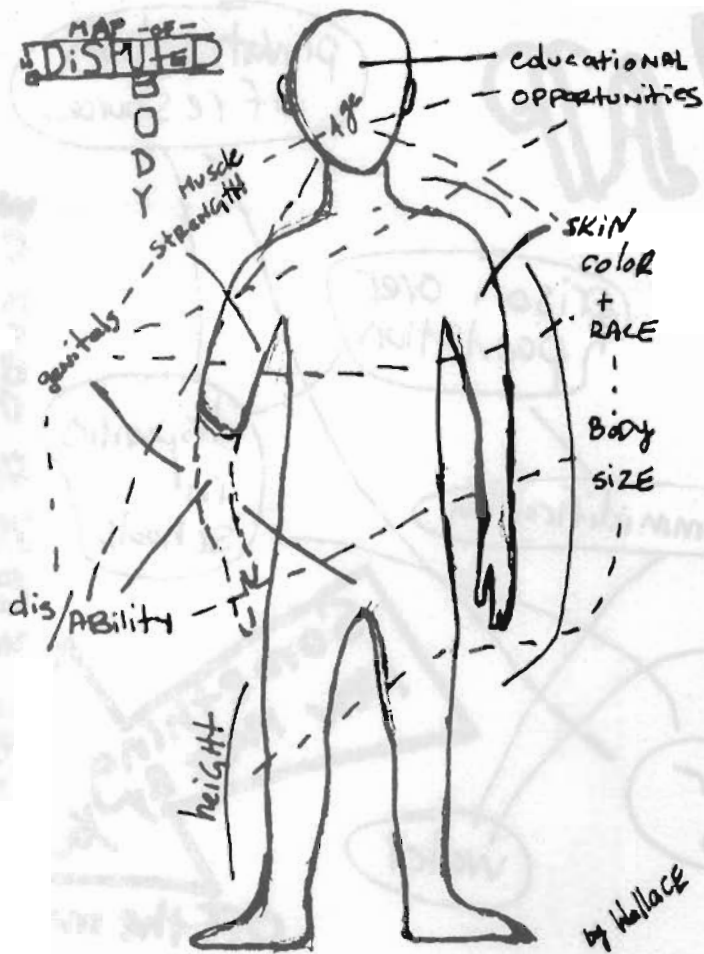
