All I know is that it's us against the world

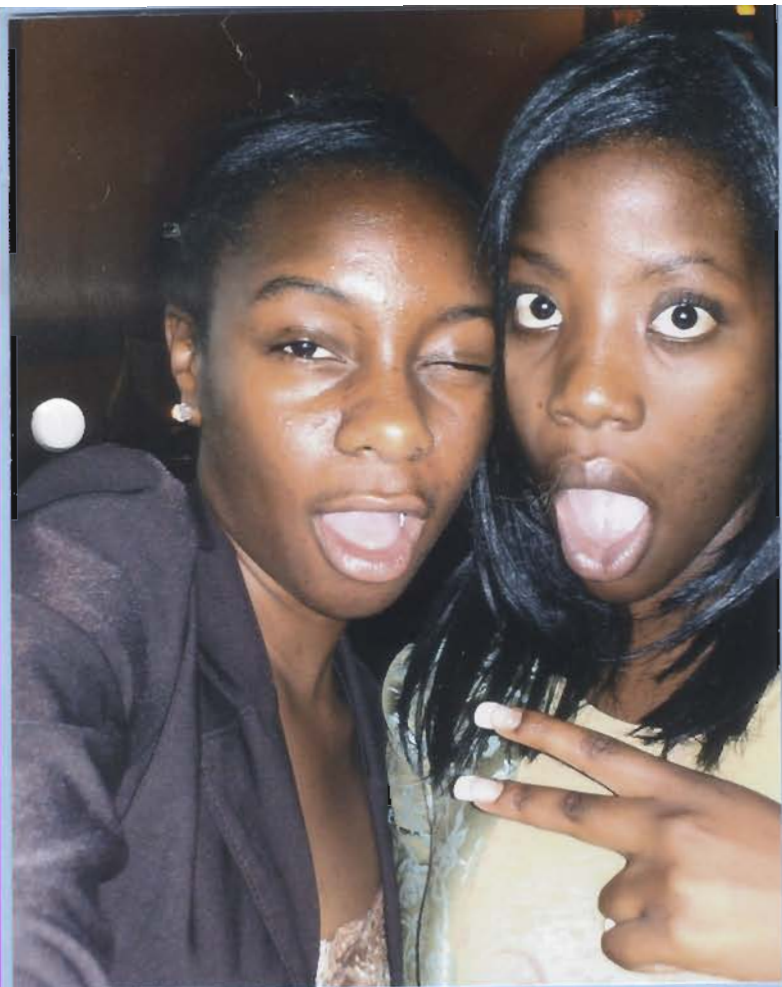
